

Tree Maintenance Along Boardwalk – September 2023

Issue:

There are 9 trees along the boardwalk. According to neighbor's recent survey, & property line stakes, 8 trees are entirely on our property with only one---the black walnut, possibly being on the line, but mostly on our side. Neighbors given permission to do work from their side.



Problems:

- Trees along Boardwalk are in contact with buildings and the roofs.
- A large box elder is split and rotted at the base of trunk—half the tree is supported only by a second tree. Both are leaning toward Building 5. The second tree, also a box elder, is completely entangled with the first box elder, making it difficult & somewhat dangerous to remove the first tree without taking the second tree.
- Limbs overhanging neighbors side need to be trimmed to avoid falling on neighbor's property.
